REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to August 4, 2004, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from April 1, 2004, the date of service of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On March 31, 2004, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On May 4, 2004, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The Petitioner represented that the final decision was received on April 1, 2004. (Exhibit B)
- 3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.


The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the High Priority Corrective Action Plan Budget (budget) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This budget, dated February 02, 2004, was received by the Illinois EPA on February 05, 2004. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

The budget is modified pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(4) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.405(c). Based on the modifications listed in Section 2 of Attachment A, the amounts listed in Section 1 of Attachment A are approved. Please note that the costs must be incurred in accordance with the approved plan. Be aware that the amount of reimbursement may be limited by Sections 57.8(e), 57.8(g) and 57.8(d) of the Act, as well as 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.604, 732.606(s), and 732.611.

The Budget Letter discussed the following:

- a. The consultant is concerned with reduction of 1650.00 in personnel reimbursement costs.
- b. The consultant is concerned with personnel reductions made by the IEPA,
- c. The consultant is concerned with waste water disposal costs reduced to approximately \$1.00 per gallon.

a. "Part of the \$16,500 deduction is the result of approval of the \$2,200 in Site Classification Reimbursements from the Site classification Work Plan Budget dated April 09, 2002. For reimbursement of the HPCAP Reimbursement Claim, the Agency has reviewed the activities to be completed as part of the plan and approved a reasonable amount of personnel dollars for this effort."

b. Personnel cuts:

"The Agency has reviewed the activities to be completed as part of the plan and approved a reasonable amount of personnel dollars for this effort.

We do not specify number of hours or type of personnel expected to complete the proposed activities, only a reasonable total amount. How a consultant chooses to use this amount (type of personnel used and number of hours) is up to them as long as the approved total amount is not exceeded and the personnel rates are reasonable.

c. Wastewater disposal costs on a per drum cost has been adjusted in Attachment A.
