ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie):

On August 26, 2024, the Sierra Club and Prairie Rivers Network (Petitioners) filed a motion to dismiss this petition for review with prejudice (Mot.). On May 10, 2022, Petitioners had filed a petition for review of an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) decision that re-issued a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit (Permit) to Williamson Energy, LLC (Williamson). The petition for review alleged that the Permit was issued by IEPA in violation of certain provisions of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5 (2022)) (Act). On August 26, 2024, along with the motion to dismiss, Petitioners filed a settlement agreement with respondent Williamson. Mot., Ex. A. The Board grants Petitioner’s motion to dismiss with prejudice, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
