

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.P. Novak):

On June 9, 2004, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Telzrow Oil Company may appeal a June 8, 2004 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.402, 105.406. Because the postmark date of the joint request is within the time for filing, the joint request was timely filed. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2), 105.404. The Agency rejected petitioner's high priority corrective action plan for Telzrow Oil Company's leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at Main and Park Streets, Hardin, Calhoun County. The Board extends the appeal period until September 7, 2004, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Telzrow Oil Company fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
