	violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415	
	ILCS $5/21(p)(1)(2022)$), as alleged. Because there was one violation	
	of Section 21(p), the Board ordered Beauty of the Land to pay a total	
	civil penalty of \$1,500, reflecting the statutory penalty of \$1,500 per	
	violation.
