AMEREN ENERGY MEDIAN VALLEY COGEN LLC'S MOTION TO EXTEND DISCOVERY

Ameren Energy Medina Valley Cogen, LLC ("Ameren"), pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.522, requests that the Hearing Officer enter an order extending the discovery deadline to 90 days after the end of the stay or 90 days after the Board's decision on the stay, whichever is later. In support thereof, Ameren states as follows:

- 1. On August 14, 2024, Ameren's Motion to Extend Discovery Period was filed, and on August 26, 2024, the Hearing Officer granted the unopposed motion, extending the discovery period to October 20, 2024.
- 2. On October 18, 2024, Ameren filed an agreed motion to extend the discovery period for 90 days, which the Hearing Officer granted on October 21, 2024.
- 3. There is good cause to extend discovery. Concurrent with this Motion, Ameren is filing a Motion to Stay the proceeding for 180-days to conduct an evaluation of an alternative to a Part 845 closure. While Ameren recognizes that the Old Meredosia Pond is a CCR surface impoundment, because it was closed over 50 years ago, its surface has an established ecosystem that supports sensitive species, including a Bald Eagle's nest. The purpose of the evaluation is to conduct a treatability study to evaluate alternative methods to treat the groundwater and also avoid destroying the ecosystem on the surface. In the interim, Ameren will begin the process of preparing an operating permit application for the Old Meredosia Pond.

4. Ameren seeks an extension of the discovery period to 90 days after the end of the

stay or 90 days after the Board's decision on the stay, whichever is later, to give the parties time to

review the results of the treatability study, and conduct any additional written and oral discovery, if

needed.

5. Ameren has reached out to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency")

on its request for an extension, but as of this filing Ameren has not received a response from the

Agency.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Energy Medina Valley Cogen, LLC requests that the Hearing

Officer grant its Motion to Extend Discovery to 90 days after the end of the stay or 90 days

after the Board's decision on the stay, whichever is later.
