MINUTES OF FORMAL BOARD MEETING
June 9, 1971 Danville, Illinois

Mr. Currie and Mr. Aldrich were not present.

In ##70-7, 12, 13, & 14, League of Women Voters v. NSSD, Mr. Kissel explained his draft opinion and order regarding interim treatment at the District's various plants. Mr. Kissel agreed to amend the order so that it would not affect the order in the phosphate treatment variance request in #71-36, North Shore Sanitary District v. EPA.

Opinions in the following cases were adopted: ##71-16, Allied Mills, supporting a May 26 order; 71-30, EPA v. C.E. Koons; 71-31 EPA v. Southern Illinois Asphalt, Mr. Lawton will file a concurring opinion; 71-47, Northern Petrochemical Co.; 71-54, Truax-Traer Coal Co.; 71-55, Electric Wheel Co.; 71-56 City of Lincoln.

In PCB71-36, North Shore Sanitary District v. EPA, the request for variance with regard to phosphate regulations was denied.

Decisions in ##71-41, EPA v. Clay Products and 71-57, 71-58, Trojan were put over to another Board meeting.

The opinion and regulations in R70-2, Lake Michigan Thermal Standards were adopted.

Mr. Kissel's opinion and order consolidating R70-2, Des Plaines water quality standards, with R71-14, Water Quality Standards, was adopted.

R71-16, Asbestos Regulations and R71-17, Emission Standards for Hydrocarbons, Carbon Monoxide and Oxides of Nitrogen from Stationary Sources were authorized for hearings.

Hearings were authorized for new cases ##71-129, Commonwealth Edison; 71-132, American National Bank; 71-133, Thomas and Sandra Kaeding; 71-136, Arthur Zamost.

The following cases were ordered held pending EPA recommendations; ##71-127, Illinois State Fairground; 71-128, City of Zion; 71-130, Chicago Dubuque Foundry; 71-131, Willow Creek Drainage District; 71-134 Union Oil Co; 71-135, Ravinia Festival.
