

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
March 7, 1974 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##73-323, Laflin Salvage; 73-483, Ill. Power; 73-512, G. E.; 73-519, Salem; 73-523, General Foods; 73-525, Abex; 73-530, Hyon; 73-545, St. Charles; 73-554, Airway Products; 74-4, Olin.

An opinion and order was adopted in #73-65, CILCO, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Henss dissented.

An opinion and order was adopted in #73-193, Fleischman, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Marder dissented.

In #73-562, Mobil Oil, an opinion and order was adopted by a vote of 3-2, Mr. Henss and Mr. Seaman dissented.

Motion for decision without hearing in #73-82, Olin was granted 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

An opinion and order was adopted on motion for clarification and review of hearing officer order in #73-372 through 379, and 74-16, Commonwealth Edison by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion for reconsideration was denied in #73-492, Foreman by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

In #73-527, Champaign, the Agency was granted an additional 21 days to file a recommendation by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion to reopen in #74-2, Merck Farms was denied 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Parties were present in #74-5, Alton Box Board and answered questions presented by the Board. The Board reconsidered a vote to deny motion for interim variance taken on February 28, 1974 by a vote of 5-0.

The Board then granted an interim variance until June 20, 1974 by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

A hearing was authorized in #74-65, Mt. Vernon and the Agency was allowed time to file a recommendation by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion filed by Village of Lombard in #R70-17, DuPage, Region IV, was dismissed 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

An interim order in #74-1, Abex was adopted 5-0 requesting additional information.

A waiver of one week from March 7, 1974 was given in #73-528, Interlake. Mr. Peter Orlinsky of the EPA gave the waiver on behalf of Mr. Gerald Thursby, attorney for Petitioner.

The Board voted 5-0 to request the Agency to investigate a sewer problem in the Ridgewood area of Joliet, Illinois pursuant to Section 30 of the Act.
