

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
March 14, 1974 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: #71-348 and 72-73, Darling & Co.; 73-208, National By-Products; 73-288, Highland; 73-336, Shallenberger; 73-344, Howell; 73-394, Holiday Inn; 73-469, Secretary of State; 73-531, Midland-Ross; 73-535, Murphy; 73-540, G.E.; 73-541, Dundee Cement; 73-543, Velsicol.

Pursuant to record filed, these cases were withdrawn and dismissed: ##73-458, -549, Continental Can. The vote was 5-0 and Mr. Marder will prepare an order.

In #73-565, Seaway Bldg., Mr. Peter Orlinsky stated that a motion to dismiss filed by the Agency would be withdrawn. There was no need for Board action.

Motion to dismiss in #72-270, Marblehead Lime was held to 3-21 pending receipt of Agency response.

Motions in #74-20, C. B. E. v. Circuit Etchings and in 74-27, Olin were discussed and held to 3-21 for action.

Motion to withdraw petition in #74-58, Triangle was allowed by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Seaman was not present. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Objection and motion for hearing was allowed in #74-71, Strombeck by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Seaman was not present. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Minutes as amended were approved for February 28, 1974 and March 7, 1974 by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Seaman was not present.

These cases were discussed and set for further discussion and possible decision March 21, 1974: ##72-114, Apex; 72-425, -505, Laclede; 73-2, Denny; 73-21, Herrin; 73-552, Vena; 73-559, International Harvester; 73-560, Potter; 73-563, -564, Mobil Oil.

A proposed amendment to Water Quality Standards, Section 204, was authorized to be heard at hearing set for April 9, 1974 on R73-13, Public Water Supply.

In new cases these actions were taken:

These new cases, all citizen enforcement actions, were held to March 21, 1974 for determination by Board on hearing authorizations: ##74-83, Rutland E. P. A. v. Board of Supervisors et al; 74-85, LaVerne Hromec v, Lakeland Park Water Co.; 74-87, C.B.E. v. Commonwealth Edison.

These new cases were ordered held for Agency recommendations: ##74-89, Flintkote Co.; 74-90, Ridgeview Development Co.; 74-91, County of Piatt.

The Board vote 4-0 to request the Attorney General to represent them on a summons filed by U. S. Steel at Waukegan, Illinois. Richard Cosby, Assistant Attorney General, was present and agreed to represent the Board. Mr. Seaman was not present for the discussion or the vote.

The Board vote 4-0 to deny a motion by the State EPA to suspend proceedings in #R73-11, -12, NPDES until September 5, 1974. Mr. Henss will prepare an order. Mr. Seaman was not present for the discussion or vote.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered placed on the Agenda for March 21, 1974.
