MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
June 8, 1978 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: #76-30, Dupont; 76-155, Chicago and North Western et al; 77-206, Ralston Purina (Interim); 77-208, Southern California Chemical; 78-57, Cerro Gordo; 78-59, Cerro Gordo; 78-89, Lake Zurich; 78-97, Mobil Oil.

An Opinion in R75-11, Motor Racing Noise Regulations was adopted by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Young dissented.

Joint motion for continuance was granted in #77-90, Shell Oil Co. by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to consolidate in #77-276 and 78-104, Zimco was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order. Motion to extend time was denied in #78-104, Zimco by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

Motion to correct clerical error in #77-292, Skaggs Construction was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order. Motion for clarification in #77-292, Skaggs was dismissed by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

The Board adopted an Order in #77-294, Buerkett et al denying a motion for rehearing and a motion to vacate et al and ruling on a motion for clarification. The vote was 5-0 and Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

An Order was adopted in the matter of an interlocutory appeal in #78-14, Oscar Mayer by a vote of 4-1. Mr. Werner dissented and Mr. Young will prepare the Order.

Motion for extension of time was granted in #78-78, CIPS by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to file an intervening petition in #78-107, Zahradka was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #78-133, Murdale was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to consolidate in #77-275 and 78-103, Korte was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to vacate in #77-291, Brewer was denied by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Goodman abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.


An Interim Order was adopted in #77-147, C.M. Ford by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare the Order.
