Minutes of Regular Board Meeting  
February 1, 1979 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Dr. Satchell, who was ill.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0. ##78-257, Bureau of Alcohol et al.; 78-277, Mobil Oil; 78-281, Quincy Soybean.

Motion to stay in #74-234, American Brick was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #77-332, Crystal Lake was accepted and set for decision on February 15, 1979 by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

Motion to reinstate in #78-109, Celotex was granted by a vote of 4-0. The 90 day time period will run from the date of filing of the motion and a hearing was authorized. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to waive a hearing in #78-115, Kelsey-Hayes was granted and set for decision on February 15, 1979.

A letter received in the matter of #78-173, Shodeen was denied in so far as it was construed as a motion for reconsideration by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to assign another Hearing Officer in #78-295, City of East St. Louis was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #78-303, Goodyear was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to intervene and objection by Village of Bolingbrook in #78-313, Citizens Utilities was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #79-5, Crossroads was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw motion to strike in #79-9 Beker was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to waive hearing in #78-176, Marathon Oil was granted by a vote of 4-0 and ordered assigned for decision.

Motion for continuance in #78-193, Valley View was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in R77-9 and 79-7, Illinois Power which incorporated the record in R77-9 into #79-7 by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Parties were present in #79-10, Zajac v. C.T.A. The matter was held to February 15, 1979 for consideration.

A hearing was authorized in #79-11, Brogan v. Palos Hills by a vote of 4-0.

##79-14, Outboard Marine and 79-15, EPA v. Western Utilities were held to February 15, 1979 for consideration.

Hearings are mandatory in these new cases: ##79-16, EPA v. William Millas et al.; 79-17, EPA v. Village of Mahomet; 79-18, EPA v. U.S. Postal Service; 79-19, EPA v. Jack Chase; 79-20, EPA v. The Wiggins Ferry Co.

R79-3, Proposed Revisions to Rule 102 of Chapter 2, A.Q.S. and R79-4, Particulate Emission Standards for Watercraft Loading of Grain were authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 4-0.


