

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
MAY 29, 1980 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present save Dr. Satchell who was absent due to transportation difficulties.

Mr. Goodman presented all matters assigned to Dr. Satchell on his behalf.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 4-0 in these cases: #77-345, Panozzo; 78-232, Village of Wyanet; 79-221, Continental Grain; 80-9, Nadelhoffer-Wilson (Opinion only); 80-65, Bellmont.

An Order was adopted in R78-9, Air Pollution Regulations Amendments, Rules 203(e) and 206(b), which ordered that the regulations as adopted on April 3, 1980 be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State and published in the Illinois Register. The vote was 4-0, Dr. Satchell will prepare the Order.

Motion to reinstate in #77-322, Waukegan, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to stay penalty in #78-28, Rapid Liquid Waste, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare the Order.

Motion to withdraw in #79-37, Beker, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to modify in #79-86, Philipsborn, was denied as premature by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #79-135, Bunge Corporation, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to set aside order in #79-145, Celotex, was denied by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Werner abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to supplement was granted in #79-221, Continental Grain, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss was granted in #79-252, Texaco, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to defer was granted in #79-266, U.S. Steel, by a vote of 4-0. A representative for U.S. Steel was asked to file an addendum to the motion as filed and he agreed. The Order will be prepared by Mr. Goodman.

Motion for oral argument in #80-19, Mississippi River Grain, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted on a request for modification by #80-50, Pulte Homes, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to dismiss in #80-58, Willowbrook, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Motion to reconsider in #80-60, Hillside was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #80-76, Admiral, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Objections having been filed, hearings were authorized in ##80-79 and 80-80, Knoxville, by a vote of 4-0.

An Order was adopted on a motion for discovery in R77-15 et al, Sulfur Dioxide, by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Werner abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to stay in #79-195, Borden, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #80-62, Riley Oil, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Joint motion to extend time for hearing in #79-141, Out-board Marine, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An amended petition filed in #80-27, E. Peoria, was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

Additional information was requested on the amended petition filed in #80-73, Morris. Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Order.

Amended petitions filed in #80-86, Belvidere and #80-91, Norris City, were ordered held for Agency recommendations.

Minutes as amended were approved by a vote of 4-0 for Board meetings held on March 6, 20; April 3 and 17, 1980.

The Board decided to cancel the regular meeting scheduled for June 26, 1980 since some of the members would be attending the Air Pollution Conference in Montreal.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on June 12, 1980.
