Minutes of Regular Board Meeting  
July 24, 1980 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 77-183, Domestic Utilities; 78-264, Kewanee, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 79-135, Bunge Corp.; 80-45, Sanchez Energy; 80-55, Medusa; 80-79,-80, Knoxville; 80-82, C. Iber; 80-86, Belvidere; 80-106, Franklin Grove.

A Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted in R76-14,-19, Forging Noise, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Werner dissented.

A final Order and final Opinion were adopted in R76-20, R77-10, Mine Waste Amendments by a vote of 5-0.

A final Order was adopted in R79-13, WQS Amendments, Rule 902, by a vote of 5-0.

Motion to stay was denied in #76-80, Allaert Rendering by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Werner dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Petition for supplemental Order in # 77-190, Klairmont, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #77-286, Burlington, was denied by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss was granted in # 78-54, Amoco, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #79-166, Shell Oil, denying motion to dismiss and asking for an amended petition. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #79-277, DuPage was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An objection was filed in #80-122, DuPage and a hearing authorized by a vote of 5-0.

Motion to stay was granted in #80-126, Olin, by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

In R79-14, AQS Amendments, motion to withdraw and substitute was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #77-206, Ralston Purina, by a vote fo 4-0. Mr. Goodman abstained and Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Order was adopted in #80-73, Morris, by a vote of 5-0.

Interim Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 78-137, Salem; 79-110, Dutton v. Crest Hill; 79-161, Stepan Chemical; 80-85, Allis-Chalmers.

An Interim Order was adopted in #80-91, Norris, by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Goodman abstained.

An Order was adopted in R76-10, Special Waste Amendments, which adopted an emergency rule. The vote was 5-0, Dr. Satchell will prepare the Order.

A Proposed Rule, First Notice was adopted in R80-7, Procedural Rules Amendments, by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Werner dissented.

An amended petition in #80-103, Village of Homewood was authorized for hearing.


Additional information was requested on the amended petition filed in #80-127, Marathon Oil. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
