MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
January 27, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board members were present.

Opinions and orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
##80-49, East St. Louis (Interim order): 82-28, Wauconda; 82-131, IBP, Inc. Mr. Dumelle will file a supplemental statement.

R78-15 Rochelle Site Specific Rule, was adopted as a Proposed Rule, Second Notice by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner concurred.

A second motion to modify in ##75-80,-141, U.S. Steel, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

Motion to release exhibits was granted in #79-122, Caseyville, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motion for reconsideration in #80-111, Caterpillar Tractor, was denied by a vote of 4-1. Mrs. Anderson concurred, and Mr. Anderson dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-48, Land & Lakes, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-134, Donovan, was ordered taken with the case by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an order.

Waiver of hearing was accepted in #81-177, Hansen. The case will be placed on an agenda for decision.

Motion to cancel hearing and incorporate a record was granted in #82-21, Galesburg, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Motion for stay in #82-23, Trojan was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an order.

Motion to stay in #82-101, Browning - Ferris, was denied by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an order.

Joint motion to modify in #82-117, West Frankfort, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

Pursuant to the objections filed, a hearing was authorized in #82-150, Gilt Edge Farms.
