MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING

February 10, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board members were present

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ##80-174 and 81-49, Rowe Foundry, Mr. Werner concurred; 81-20, Metro-East, Interim Order; 81-116, Victory Memorial Hospital; 81-157, Rome Waterworks, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 82-9, Arvey Corp.; 82-110, All Steel.

In R81-29, Pfizer, a Proposed Rule, First Notice Order was adopted by a vote of 5-0.

In R81-30, Trade Secrets, Proposed Rule, First Notice Order was adopted by a vote of 5-0. A proposed opinion will be considered on February 24, 1983.

An order was adopted in #82-22, Olin, on a motion for modification by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an order.

Motion to reconsider in #82-129, Will County Produce, was denied by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner dissented. Ms. Anderson will prepare an order.

Motion to withdraw in #82-130, SCA, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #82-145, Seneca, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.

In #82-151, Phillips, a motion to dismiss was denied and a motion to stay was granted. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

Motion for stay in #83-10, Frink's, was granted by a vote of 5-0, Ms. Anderson concurred. Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

An order was adopted in R81-20, Bubble Rule, on a motion for reconsideration. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred. Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

Motion for reconsideration in R80-22, SO₂, was denied except for certain typographical errors. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an order.

These cases were discussed and held to February 24, 1983 for further discussion or possible decision: #78-247 and 79-111,-114, Continental Grain; 80-151, Archer-Daniels-Midland; 81-177, A. S. Hansen.

An Opinion and Order in #81-171, Getty Synthetic Fuels, was adopted by a vote of 5-0.

A Proposed Rule change filed by General Tire and Rubber, was docketed R83-5 and authorized for hearing and public comment.

A Proposed Rule change for Chapter 4, Mine Waste Amendments, filed by IEPA was docketed R83-6, and authorized for hearing and public comment.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to February 24, 1983 for possible consideration.
