MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING

March 24, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
78-293, Ralston Purina; 80-71, Continental Grain; 80-151, Archer-Daniels-Midland, Mrs. Anderson concurred; 81-102, Claude Burch; 83-15, Lady of the Snows.

A Resolution was adopted in R81-16, Docket B, New Source Review, by a vote of 5-0. The Resolution was proposed to allow a draft Opinion and Order to be circulated for public comment prior to adoption.

R81-17, Combined Sewer Overflow Rules was adopted as a Final Opinion and Order by a vote of 5-0.

An Order was adopted in #78-177, Celotex, requesting briefs on the motion to issue a permit. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss #79-98, Lombard, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file a report in #80-38, Bacon's Farm, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #80-168, Caterpillar was granted by a rule of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion in limine in #80-175, Unity Ventures was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for final decision in #81-134, Donovan, was ordered taken with the case.

Motion to dismiss in #82-120, Peabody Coal, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to clarify the record in #82-141, Waste Management, was ordered taken with the case.

Motion to dismiss in #83-18, Modine, was ordered taken with the case by a vote of 3-2, Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Anderson dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to appear in #83-19, Shell, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to consolidate in #83-26,-29, Marathon Oil, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to require additional information in #83-31, Mendota, was denied by a vote of 4-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held to April 7 for further discussion or possible decision: 81-134, Donovan; 82-139, Chicago; 82-141, Waste Management; R82-5,-10, Effluent Standards Revisions.

Mr. Dumelle noted that the proponent in R82-18, Grain Handling had indicated that he would be ready for hearings in June.

The supplement filed in #82-153 and 83-11, CPC, was held to April 7 for consideration.


A second amended petition was requested for #83-9, Mt. Olive. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
