MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING

April 7, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred: ## 81-134, Donovan; 82-141, Waste Management v. Will County Board.

An Order was adopted in #82-139, Chicago, construing a supplemental filing as an amended petition. The matter was then held for an amended Agency recommendation. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #76-84, Santa Fe, motion for resumption was granted and motion to dismiss denied. Briefs were ordered. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion in #78-247, Continental Grain and 79-7, Illinois Power, were held to April 21 for consideration.

Motion to amend the record in #83-10, Frink's, was ordered taken with the case since it is due for decision on April 21, 1983.

Motion to appear in #83-24, Shell Oil, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time for filing a recommendation in #83-38, East Peoria, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss and withdraw by petitioner in #82-116, Downers Grove, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #82-90, Drelicharz v. M.S.D., by a vote of 5-0.

These cases were discussed and held to April 21 for further discussion or possible decision: #81-96, Texaco; 82-21, Galesburg; 82-148, Herrin, 83-1, Moore Graphics; 83-10, Frink's.

R80-16, Galesburg, was discussed and held to May 5 for further discussion.

R81-16, Docket B, Air Permits and R82-31, Forging Noise Sites, were discussed and held to April 21 for consideration.

The supplement filed in ##82-153 and 83-11, CPC, was construed as the variance petition. The motion to lift stay was granted and motion to consolidate denied but both matters will be assigned to the same Hearing Officer. Hearings were authorized. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

The amended petition filed in #83-37, Maple Lawn Homes was held for an Agency recommendation.
