Minutes of Regular Board Meeting  
April 21, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present. Chairman Dumelle asked for a moment of silence in respect to the memory of Vice Chairman Irvin G. Goodman.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: #82-148, City of Herrin, 83-1, Moore American Graphics.

In R81-29, Pfizer WQS Amendments, Proposed Rules, Second Notice were adopted by a vote of 4-0.

In R82-5,-10, Effluent Standards Revisions, a Proposed Rule, First Notice, were adopted by a vote of 4-0.

Motion to reconsider in #78-247 et al., Continental Grain, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Petition to amend in #79-7, Illinois Power, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Petition for approval of a facilities plan in #79-28, Lockport, was dismissed by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motions in #80-175, Unity Ventures, were held to May 5, 1983 for consideration.

The amended petiton in #83-42, Lamplight, was held for an Agency recommendation.


