MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
May 5, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0:
79-71, Minnesota Mining; 81-96, Texaco; 82-142, Georgia-Pacific;
83-20, Village of Elizabeth; 83-37, Maple Lawn Homes, (Interim
Order).

R81-19, Citizens Utilities, was dismissed by a vote of 3-1, Mr.
Anderson dissented.

R81-26, Deere Thermal Standard, was adopted as a Proposed Rule, First
Notice by a vote of 4-0.

R81-25, Halogenated Solvents, was adopted as a Proposed Rule, First
Notice by a vote of 4-0.

In #80-151, Archer-Daniels-Midland, motion for stay as to penalty only
was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-175, Unity Ventures on a motion to set
hearing and a motion to reconsider. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson
will prepare an Order.

Motions to dismiss in #82-26, -38, -67, Growmark, were granted by a
vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for modification in #82-53, Meyercord, was granted by a vote
of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file record was granted in #83-41,
Frink's, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #83-43, Taracorp, on a motion for extension
and a motion for stay. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare
an Order.

The Board on its own motion cancelled a hearing in #83-5, EPA v.
Salem. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A motion to cancel a hearing in #R82-21, Special Waste Hauling Per-
mits, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an
Order.

A motion to reconsider the final Order in R77-10, Mine Waste Amend-
ments was denied. The motion was construed as a request to add
additional proposal to R83-6 and docketed as Docket B. The vote

was 4-0, Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held to May 19, 1983 for further discussion or possible decision: # 82-21, Galesburg; 82-138, Lewis; 82-147, Del Monte; 82-150, Gilt Edge; 83-25, Army; 79-167, Continental; 83-10, Frink's.

The amended petition in #83-9, Mt. Olive, was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

In #83-21, Oak Grove, a second amended petition was requested by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #83-47, Fedders, U.S.A., an Order was adopted indicating to the petitioner the reason for a hearing being authorized. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
