May 19, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

In R82-12, Air Amendments, Lead, a Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted by a vote of 4-0.

In R82-31, Forging Noise Amendments, a Proposed Rule, First Notice and a Proposed Opinion were adopted by a vote of 4-0.

In #80-71, Continental Grain, motion for reconsideration was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
