MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
June 2, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Bids for court reporting services for FY 84 were opened and announced. Bids were received from these services: Vallarta Reporting; Longoria and Goldstine; Pauline James and Associates; and Diane Hromek. Mrs. Wiley was asked to prepare an analysis of the bids received and the Board held the matter for consideration later in the meeting.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: # 82-123, Taylor Springs; 83-28, Top Chop.

In R81-20, Bubble, ACS, a Final Opinion and Order was adopted for Docket A by a vote of 4-0. A Proposed Rules, First Notice was adopted for Docket B by a vote of 4-0.

In #79-180, Caterpillar, an Interim Order was adopted deferring action on a motion to dismiss and giving the parties until June 20, 1983 to supplement that motion. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #80-175, Unity Ventures, the Board adopted an Order authorizing the Hearing Officer to set a hearing at a later date than previously ordered. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #81-116, Victory, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #81-149, Willowbrook, the petition was ordered to file an affidavit or be subject to a hearing. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #81-151, Dean Foods, the Board sustained the Hearing Officer's ruling pursuant to a motion for review. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

On the Board's own motions petitions in ##82-105, 106, Department of the Army, were dismissed by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Orders.

Pursuant to a waiver of hearing in #83-31, Mendota, the Board will decide the matter without a hearing.

Motion for reconsideration in #83-37, Maple Lawn, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A Proposed Rule, First Notice and a Proposed Opinion were adopted in R80-16, Galesburg, by a vote of 4-0.

Motions for extension of time to file a recommendation in #83-49, Alton, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Petition to withdraw proposal in R82-21, Waste Permits, was held to June 16, 1983 for possible consideration.

The amended petition in #83-21, Oak Grove was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

The amended petition in #83-63, City of Farmington was not sufficient and the Board decided to request a second amended petition. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

These matters were discussed and held to June 16, 1983 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 82-149, Jack Rich; 82-152, Village of Lombard; 82-156, St. Charles; 83-10, Frink's; R80-22 (B), Winnetka SO₂; R81-18, Landfill Operator Certification; R81-30, Trade Secrets.

Minutes of Board meetings held on May 5 and 19, 1983 were approved as corrected by vote of 4-0.

The Board approved a meeting schedule for FY 84 which will be announced in the Board's Environmental Register.

In new case #83-70, Shelbyville, additional information was requested by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.


A petition for a site-specific rule filed by Illinois Power and docketed as R83-11, was authorized for publication and hearing.
