MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
March 19, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
##80-215, James Noble; 80-171, Getty Fuel Oil, Dr. Satchell concurred; 80-112, Occhipinti, Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Werner concurred.

Proposed Rules, Second Notice was adopted in R77-12, WQS Amendments, Sludge, Docket B, by a vote of 5-0.

Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted in R80-19, Hazardous Hospital Wastes, by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Werner concurred.

R81-14, "RCRA" Pass-through rules were adopted by a vote of 5-0.

Motion for extension of time to file recommendation was granted in #79-49, Sterling Steel, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motions to withdraw petitions were granted in these cases: ##79-62, Consolidation Coal; 79-100, Consolidation Coal; 80-120, A.S.F. The votes were 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Orders.

Motion for stay was granted in #79-160, U.S. Steel, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motions to reconsider were granted in #80-3, Caterpillar, and leave to file further briefs was allowed. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for stay was denied in #80-131, Bemis, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-153, Hamman, which addressed motions filed by the petitioner and intervenor in the matter. The vote was 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in ##81-23, -24, Alburn, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Motion to consolidate was then denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time was granted in #80-211, Outboard Marine, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

#81-29, Caterpillar was ordered stayed pending the decision on a motion to reconsider in #80-3, Caterpillar. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-30, Quincy, was denied and additional information requested. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Dumelle concurred. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in R78-16, Air Regulation Amendments, which addressed the second motion to reconsider by the EPA. The vote was 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Village of Cooksville, hearing mandatory; 81-42, Village of Potomac, held for Agency recommendation; 81-43, Westtown Lands West, held to April 2 for consideration.

All Matters not disposed of as listed were ordered placed on an agenda for April 2, 1981 for possible consideration.
