MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
June 10, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

The meeting was called to order pursuant to notice given that the meeting would be held on this date instead of June 11, 1981 as originally scheduled.

All Board members were present save Mr. Goodman who was ill.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 77-260, A.R.F. Landfill; 80-182, Waste Control; 80-197, Jacksonville; 80-218, Mercy Hospital; 81-34, Commonwealth Edison.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-105, Abingdon, by a vote of 3-1. Mrs. Anderson dissented and Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Opinion was adopted in R80-9,-10, Blasting Noise, by a vote of 4-0.

An emergency motion for continuance in #80-189,-190, Alburn, was considered and held pending a response from the Respondent.

An Order in #78-293, Ralston-Purina, was adopted regarding an objection to Hearing Officer Order. The vote was 3-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-3, Caterpillar Tractor, on a motion to reconsider. The vote was 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

The Final Opinion and Order in #80-46, Kaji v. Olson was affirmed by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented. An Order will be prepared on behalf of Mr. Goodman.

Motion to consolidate #80-125, Welin and #81-88, Moline, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-189,-190, Alburn, which stayed contested permit conditions only. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension in #80-224, Beker, was granted to August 1, 1981 by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #80-230, Crook Development, which addressed a motion to reconsider. The vote was 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Pursuant to an objection filed, a hearing was authorized in ## 81-66,-69, Saddle Hill by a vote of 4-0.

Motion to dismiss was granted in #81-53, Amax, by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw proposal in R79-2, Sulfur Dioxide, was granted by a vote of 4-0 and the proceeding was dismissed. An Order will be prepared on behalf of Mr. Goodman.

An Order was adopted in R80-20, Solid Waste Amendments, requesting that the IEPA file additional proposed amendments. The vote was 4-0, Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order clarifying the original Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-207, Travenol, by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Joint motion for extension of time to file briefs was granted in #80-193, Caterpillar, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held to June 25, 1981 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 79-197, Carr; 80-162, Service Disposal; 80-212, Rock Island; 81-44, Granite City Steel.

R81-18, Waste Disposal Operator Site Certification, was authorized for hearing.

An Order was adopted in the matter of R81-4, Codification of Mine-Related Pollution, by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order in response to the court remand was adopted in #80-19, Mississippi River Grain, by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 4-0: ##81-86, Dubuque Packing, hearing authorized and consolidation granted with #80-95; 81-87, Sparton, hearing authorized pursuant to an objection filed; 81-89, Quincy, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 81-90, Burlington Northern, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 81-91, DuPage, held for an Agency recommendation; 81-92 and 81-93, Lake Zurich, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 81-94, Village of Burlington, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 81-95, Kennedy Oil, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 81-96, Texaco, hearing authorized.
