MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
June 25, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Goodman who was ill.

Sandra Wiley presented a summary and analysis of the court reporting bids received for FY82. The Board voted 4-0 to award the contract for court reporting services for FY82 to Longoria and Goldstine.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 79-197, Carr and Huisinga; 80-162, Service Disposal; 81-44, Granite City Steel; 81-82, Illinois Power (Opinion only).

Motion to enforce subpoena in #78-139, Vickery Manor, was ordered taken with the case.

Motion for extension of time to file a report in #79-35, Chevy Chase, was granted for 90 days by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #80-13, Granite City, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Petition to amend order in #80-229, Arlington Heights, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in #81-17, Wauconda, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in ##81-21,-22, Sierra Club, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to strike answer was granted in #81-27, Cabot, by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

In #81-48, Land and Lakes, the hearing officer's ruling on a petition to intervene was upheld. The vote was 4-0, Order by Dr. Satchell.

Motions for extension of time to file recommendations were granted by a vote of 4-0 in these cases: ##81-49, Rowe Foundry, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 81-59, Carmi, Order by Dr. Satchell; 81-64, Bianucci, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 81-66, Saddle Hill, Order by Mrs. Anderson.

An objection filed in #81-92,-93, Lake Zurich, was upheld pending clarification from objector.

Motion to clarify by CPC in the matter of R77-15, SO₂, was discussed and held for consideration at a later date.

A letter received from the Illinois Petroleum Marketers Association in the matter of R78-3,-4, Hydrocarbons, was held pending further communication from the Association.

Motion to extend comment period in R76-14, Forging Noise, was granted by a vote of 4-0. An Order will be prepared on behalf of Mr. Goodman.

Motion to dismiss in #80-205, Abbott, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Interim Order in #80-17, Daum v. Roselle, was adopted requesting a report. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held to July 9 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 79-81, Reynolds Metals; 79-134, Commonwealth Edison; 80-212, Rock Island; 80-178, CBE v. General Iron; 81-7, Watts Trucking; 81-8, Century 21; 81-12, Wauconda; 81-25, Kearney.

R81-19, Petition for Site-Specific Rule Change by Citizens Utilities was authorized for hearing and publication by a vote of 4-0.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to July 9, 1981 for possible consideration.
