MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
July 9, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board members were present. Chairman Dumelle introduced Mr. Donald Anderson, recently appointed to the Board.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson abstained from voting. ##79-134, Commonwealth Edison; 80-178, CBE v. General Iron; 81-7, Watts Trucking; 81-8, Century 21; 81-12, Wauconda; 81-25, Kearney; 81-46, Algonquin; 81-51, Hoffman Estates; 81-83, C. Groot.

After some discussion an Emergency Rule was adopted in R77-15, Sulfur Dioxide by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Werner and Mrs. Anderson abstained. Percy Angelo, representing CPC International and Wayne Wiemerslage of IEPA were present and made statements. The proceedings were transcribed.

Motion for rehearing in #75-112, Metropolitan Sanitary District, was denied by a vote of 3-0, Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for clarification in ##80-189,-190, Alburn, was set for consideration on July 15, 1981 at 3:00 P.M.. Notice of a special meeting was ordered to be given.

A Supplemental Opinion was adopted in #80-230, Crook Development, pursuant to a motion for reconsideration. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Supplemental Opinion. Mr. Anderson abstained.

An Order was adopted in R81-16, Major Source Attainment, by a vote of 4-0 pursuant to a motion for consideration and overruling. Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An amended petition filed in #81-70, Texaco, was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

A second additional information order was adopted in #81-100, Naval Air Station, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
