MINUTES OF BOARD MEETING
September 24, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Werner who was ill. Mr. Goodman presented Mr. Werner's Opinions.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 81-70, Texaco; 81-113, Convent Missionary Sisters; 74-234, American Brick; 79-35, Chevy Chase (Interim Order).

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R76-21, Effluent Standards, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman concurred.

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R78-7, Flouride Standards Amendments, by a vote of 4-0.

Motion to dismiss was granted in ## 78-285, Commonwealth Edison, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

In #80-153, Hamman, motion for oral argument was denied, leave to file intervenor's brief instanter was granted and motion to supplement ordered taken with the case. The vote was 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In 81-29, Caterpillar, motion to strike was denied, motion for leave to withdraw motion to dismiss was granted, and hearing was ordered to go forward. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to assume costs in #81-111, Village of Kirkwood, was ordered to be considered at the time of decision on the variance petition. The vote was 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss was denied in #81-127, Northern v. Kankakee Water, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

A notice filed in #79-248, CIPS, was construed as a motion to withdraw and granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held for possible decision on October 8: ##77-322, Waukegan; 78-62, Davenport Packing; 79-215, Popp & Logan; 79-256, ESL; 80-56, O'Fallon; 80-181, Illinois Fruit; 81-37, Cargill; 81-104, Illinois Fruit; 81-120, Belvidere; 81-126, DuPage; R80-18, Procedural Rules Amendments.

Pursuant to objections filed the amended petition in #81-109, Bartlett, was authorized for hearing.

Amended petition in #81-119, Mendota, was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

The amended petition and request for hearing in #81-126, DuPage, was held to October 8 for consideration.

#81-136, Ute Willutzki v. James Noble was held to October 8 for consideration as were ##81-139, 81-140 and 81-141, Illinois Department of Transportation Permits.

##81-137, Blake Water, 81-138, Hereley Grain and 81-146, Village of Rio were ordered held for Agency recommendation.

Hearings are mandatory in ##81-142, EPA v. Camerer et al., 81-143, EPA v. Wheeler et al.; 81-144, EPA v. Marathon Oil; 81-145, EPA v. Carrollton.

A Proposal for Interim Alternative Control Strategy Rules, filed by Illinois State Chamber of Commerce, was accepted and ordered consolidated for consideration under R81-20, Interim Bubble Rules. The vote was 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

The meeting was adjourned until 2:00 P.M..

The Board met to consider R77-12, WQS amendments, Docket D. Mr. Dumelle led a discussion and the matter was held to October 8 for consideration.

The Opinion adopted on September 16, 1981 in R81-22, "RCRA" was reviewed and approved for publication and distribution.

All other matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on October 8, 1981.
