Minutes of Board Meeting  
November 19, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted on these cases by a vote of 5-0:  
## 79-161, Stepan Chemical; 80-101, Lippold; 81-41, Cooksville;  
81-92, Lake Zurich.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-153, Hamman Landfill,  
by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Goodman dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #81-129, Peru by a vote of  
4-0. Mr. Anderson abstained.

Orders were adopted in ## 81-172,-173, Illinois Department of  
Transportation, authorizing Mr. Dumelle to sign permits. The  
vote was 5-0.

R81-27, New Source Performance Standards Pass-Through, was adopted  
by a vote of 5-0.

An Order was adopted in #79-81, Reynolds, which affirmed the Board's  
previous Order. The vote was 4-1, Mr. Anderson dissented.

The Board decided that no action was needed in #79-136, Glen Carbon,  
on a motion to release.

Motion to dismiss a party in #81-50, U.S. Drum, was granted by a vote  
of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #81-70, Texaco, was granted by a vote  
of 5-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #81-118, Modern Plating, was granted by a  
vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Pursuant to an objection and request for hearing, hearing was au-  
thorized in #81-138, Hereley Grain.

Motion for extension of time in #81-155, Bledsoe was granted  
by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was entered in #81-165, Prior, requesting briefs. The  
vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #81-167, ZYX Dixon, petition to intervene was granted and parties  
were asked to file briefs. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will  
prepare an Order.

In #81-149, Willowbrook, motion to dismiss was denied and a hearing was authorized by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
