**MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
SEPTEMBER 3, 1992 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS**

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #86-161, Elizabeth Street Foundry, by a vote of 7-0. (GTG)

Board Member M. Nardulli presented a draft Opinion and Order in #90-182, Ronald and Susan Tex. The draft Opinion and Order failed to carry by a vote of 3-4 with B. Forcade, J. Theodore Meyer and M. Nardulli for it, and J. Anderson, R.C. Flemal, G.T. Girard and J.C. Marlin against it. The matter will be re-assigned to another Board Member.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #91-10, Amoco Oil Company, by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)

An Interim Opinion and Order was adopted in #91-194, Residents of Cedarville, by a vote of 7-0. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AS 92-2, We-Shred-It, by a vote of 7-0. (JCM)

In R89-14(C), Groundwater Quality Standards, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (RCF)

A Resolution and Order were adopted in #RES 92-1 (R90-1(A) and R90-1(D), by a vote of 7-0. (JCM)

In R90-1(A), Toxic Air Contaminants List, an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (JCM)


