An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AC 92-5 (Docket A & B), Ronald D. and Retha M. Rawe, by a vote of 5-2. Messrs. M. Nardulli and J. Theodore Meyer dissented, and J. Anderson, J.C. Marlin, and G. Tanner Girard concurred. (BF)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AC 92-48 (Docket A & B), Delmar Donley & Don Chem, Inc., by a vote of 7-0. (GTG)

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #92-83, Harlem Township, by a vote of 5-2. Messrs. J. Theodore Meyer and M. Nardulli dissented. (BF)

In R92-10, RCRA Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 1992 through June 30, 1992), a Proposal for Public Comment, Proposed Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 7-0. (JA)

Petitioner's motion to schedule a hearing was granted in #92-10, Kelly Williamson Company, by a vote of 7-0. (BF) (Thereafter J. Theodore Meyer introduced his new secretary, Jennifer Moore)

An Order granting a motion for substitution of counsel for Respondent XL Disposal Corporation, and granting Petitioners' motion for reconsideration, and upon reconsideration, the Board reaffirmed its August 13, 1992 Opinion and Order, was adopted in #92-55, Stephen A. Smith et al., by a vote of 5-1. B. Forcade dissented, and J.C. Marlin abstained. (JTM)

Petitioner's motion to voluntarily dismiss was granted in #92-94, Marsco Manufacturing Company, by a vote of 7-0. (GTG)

By a vote of 7-0, Respondent's motion to dismiss and Petitioner's motion to declare siting to be deemed approved or, alternatively, motion to strike, or alternatively, motion to take with case were denied, and the parties are free to reintroduce these issues at the hearing in #92-132, LeRoy Brown and Sons. (GTG)
