MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

February 17, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Werner who was ill.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 77-49, Illinois Central Gulf R.R.; 78-88,-225, Sundale Sewer; 80-126, Olin, Mr. Goodman concurred; 80-189,-190, Alburn; 81-117, Olin; 81-142, Mike Cammerer; 81-148, Oak Grove.

Pursuant to a joint motion requesting as order, the Board remanded the permit in #79-243, Illinois Power, to the Agency for consideration. The vote was 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare the Order.

Motion to dismiss in #80-38, Bacon's Farm, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #80-114, Kraemer, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-190, Chicago, was denied in part and granted in part, by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In consideration of an objection filed in #81-207, Bloomingdale, a hearing was authorized by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

The Board adopted an Order responding to a motion for reconsideration in R76-21, WQS, Effluent, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion by the Illinois Attorney General to extend the time for written comments was granted until March 15, 1982 in the matter of R77-12, Docket D. The vote was 3-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to continue on #81-160, Chicago Hospital Council, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.
