MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
July 1, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
82-12, Aurora; 82-45, Texaco.

R81-6,-28, Public Water Supply Amendments were adopted for second notice purposes by a vote of 5-0.

Motion for extension of time to respond in #78-233, Granite City, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to response to motion to vacate in #80-125, Welin, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for an Order in #80-175, Unity Ventures, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to correct in #80-224, Beker, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to allocate costs in #81-188, American Fly Ash, was ordered taken with the case.

Motion to withdraw in #82-14, Good Hope, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Since an objection to a recommendation was filed by the petitioner in #82-23, Trojan, a hearing was authorized. The Board noted that the 90 day decision period for decision started from the date of filing of the objection.

An emergency motion for stay in #82-68, Trade Waste, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

#77-339, Cary was dismissed by a vote of 5-0, no amended petition was filed. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

#82-22, Engineered Coated Products, was ordered to hearing by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held to the next meeting for further discussion or possible decision: ## 80-75, Springman; 81-3, Goldstein Hog Farm; 81-145, Carrollton; 81-188, American Fly Ash; 82-20, Sobel; 82-57, Westowns; 81-59, Carmi.

A Final Order was adopted in R81-5, Codification of Agriculture Related Pollution; by a vote of 5-0.

Proposed Rule, First Notice was adopted in R81-20, Final Bubble Rules, by a vote of 5-0.

Proposed Rule, First Notice and Proposed Opinion were adopted in R81-21, Freeport Site Specific Rule by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Goodman concurred.

R80-22, SO₂ and R81-11, Trihalomethanes were discussed.

Minutes of meetings held May 27, June 10 and June 14, 1982, were adopted by a vote of 5-0.

The Board decided to change the regular Board meeting schedule as follows: July 15 was changed to July 21; September 30 was changed to October 5. The Clerk was asked to post a notice of the revised meeting schedule.
