ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On April 1, 2025, the Board received from the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) a letter signed by Ron Coupet, Manager of Environmental Field Operations, asking the Board to review a February 26, 2025 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). See 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206. The determination concerns UPRR’s terminal at 3201 Plank Road in Dupo, St. Clair County.

On April 17, 2025, the Board accepted the letter as a timely petition for review but directed UPRR to file an amended petition to cure deficiencies identified in the order by May 19, 2025, or the case would be dismissed. Because UPRR failed to timely file an amended petition, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
