
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On June 5, 2025, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference. On May 7, 2025, and May 28, 2025, the parties filed a plethora of discovery documents. Also on May 28, 2025, complainant filed a motion for summary judgement. The parties also reported that respondent has installed a tarp that covers the slats in the fence and therefore obscures the sightline into complainant’s backyard. The tarp has been in use for about 5-6 weeks. Complainant stated that the noise level is “definitely better”, but that she does not know if the dog is outside as much or if respondent is keeping the dog inside “until this is over.”

Respondent’s attorney suggested that the parties enroll in “Chicago Center for Conflict Resolution” (Center). Complainant did not object. Respondent’s attorney stated that the Center will contact the complainant to schedule a date with the mediator. The complainant also did not object to respondent’s oral motion for an extension of time to file his response to her motion for summary judgement. Respondent’s response is due July 10, 2025.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on June 26, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant by calling the number below, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




