MEMORANDUM IN OPPOSITION TO APPLICANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS PETITION FOR REVIEW

Citizens Against Landfill Expansion, an unincorporated association of residents of Livingston County (hereinafter "CALE"), hereby opposes the Motion to Dismiss filed by American Disposal Services of Illinois, Inc. ("Applicant") on July 3, 2003. Applicant attempts to avoid review of the siting of a 160-acre, 50-million-cubic-yard expansion of the Livingston Landfill located in Pontiac, Livingston County, Illinois on grounds that CALE did not participate in the local siting hearing. The Motion to Dismiss should be denied with prejudice for the reasons set forth below and reasonable fees and expenses awarded to Petitioner. In the alternative, Petitioner requests leave to amend the Petition to Review to name individual members of CALE as additional Petitioners, as set forth in Petitioner's Motion for Leave to Amend being filed at the same time as this Memorandum.

I. <u>CALE fully participated in the local siting hearings.</u>

CALE is an unincorporated, voluntary association of residents of Livingston County who oppose expansion of the Livingston Landfill. As such, it has no separate legal identity as a corporation would have. Rather, it can act only through its individual members or agents. CALE actively participated in the siting hearings held March 10-14, 2003, regarding the proposed expansion.

The statute concerning appeal does not require a formal "appearance" by a citizens' group. It states only that "a third party...who participated in the hearing conducted by the county board...may...petition the Board for a hearing to contest the

approval of the county board." 415 ILCS 120/40.1(b). As an unincorporated, voluntary association of citizens, CALE participated in all aspects of the siting process through its members and counsel.

A. <u>CALE participated in the siting hearings directly through</u> individual members.

Many members of CALE actively and directly participated in the hearings. For example, Mrs. Doris Burnside of rural Pontiac is a member of CALE. See Affidavit of Doris Burnside, Exhibit A. Mrs. Burnside sat at the objectors' table with counsel for CALE throughout the five days and two evenings of testimony. Id. She also made a public comment and submitted documents that became part of the record. See Transcript, Pages 665-670.

Mrs. Julie Russow of Cornell is also a member of CALE. See Affidavit of Julie Russow, attached hereto as Exhibit B. Mrs. Russow made a public comment and submitted written comment after the hearing. See Affidavit of Julie Russow, Exhibit B. Mrs. Russow attended virtually all the afternoon and evening sessions of the hearings. See id. As Applicant states in its Motion to Dismiss, Mrs. Russow made direct reference to CALE during her public comments. Motion to Dismiss, para. 5 (referring to Transcript, Page 641.)

Other members of CALE that participated directly in the hearings include: Mrs. Phyllis Ryan of Pontiac, who made a public comment (see Transcript, Pages 660-64 & statement of Phyllis Ryan, attached hereto as Exhibit C) and Ms. Barb Christensen of Dwight, who made a public comment (see Transcript Pages 1397-1410 & statement of Barb Christensen, attached hereto as Exhibit D). Several others made comments, oral or written, as well. If the Pollution Control Board ("PCB") deems it necessary for CALE to submit affidavits from additional participants, CALE will be happy to do so upon request.

Members of CALE who did not personally attend the hearings were represented by Mrs. Burnside, Mrs. Russow, Ms. Christensen and Ms. Gerwin. See Statements of over 90 individuals, attached as Attachment 2 to the Affidavit of Doris Burnside, Exhibit A, in which each individual affirms that they are a member of CALE and that they were represented at the hearing by these individuals. Thus, through its members, CALE participated in all aspects of the siting process.

B. CALE also participated in the siting hearings through counsel.

CALE further participated in the siting hearings through counsel. The siting ordinance does not indicate that an unincorporated, voluntary association of citizens must file a formal "entry of appearance." It requires only that "members of the public who desire to be participants in the hearing must submit written notification ... to the County Clerk ten days before the first day of the public hearing." Livingston County Siting Ordinance, para. 11, attached hereto as Exhibit E. As Applicant noted in its Motion, Ms.

Gerwin provided notice of her intent to participate, Motion to Dismiss, para. 3, and other members of CALE signed up individually.

Ms. Gerwin participated extensively in the hearings, attending every session and cross-examining all Applicant's witnesses. See Transcript, *passim*. On behalf of CALE, Ms. Gerwin also presented witnesses, including hydrogeologist Professor Sondra Sixberry of Olivet Nazarene University, who was compensated by CALE and testified on its behalf. See Transcript, Page 1289, a printout of which is attached as Exhibit F.

Applicant claims, however, that it should be permitted to avoid review of the siting decision on grounds that counsel for CALE used the terms "several private citizens" and "other objectors" to refer to an unincorporated, voluntary association of private citizens. See Motion to Dismiss, para. 4. Neither Applicant, nor the Livingston County Board, nor the Hearing Officer objected to Ms. Gerwin's statements, nor did they request any further identification of such other objectors or the citizens group.

In its argument, Applicant failed to mention that during the hearing itself, in discussing Professor Sondra Sixberry's qualification to testify, Ms. Gerwin clearly stated, "[s]he's providing services not to the governmental body but to our citizens group." Transcript, Page 1289 (emphasis added), Exhibit F. Thus, an expert witness clearly identified as representing the citizens group testified at the siting hearing. Again, none of the participants protested, questioned the reference to the citizens group, or asked for further identification of the group.

In point of fact, no such further identification would have been necessary. Ms. Gerwin, Mrs. Burnside, and Mrs. Russow were well known by Applicant to be leaders of CALE. By that time, CALE had been actively opposing the expansion for many months. When Applicant began the process of applying for the proposed expansion in spring of 2002, members of CALE collected hundreds of signatures of concerned citizens who opposed expansion. See Petitions to Oppose, Affidavit of Doris Burnside, Exhibit. A. (Applicant withdrew its first application on October 8, 2002, because it failed to give proper notice as required under the statute.) The petitions variously refer to the group both by "Livingston County Conservation Committee," and by "Citizens Against Landfill Expansion." The name was changed early on to prevent confusion with any governmental agency, but it was the same group, using the same post office box, that quickly became known as CALE. Ms. Gerwin presented copies of the petitions at meetings of the Livingston County Board. See Affidavit of Doris Burnside, Exhibit A. Newspaper reports referred to CALE and identified Ms. Gerwin and Mrs. Russow by name. See Affidavit of Julie Russow, Exhibit B. Furthermore, members of CALE, including Ms. Gerwin and Mrs. Burnside, met with landfill representatives at the landfill's offices on two separate occasions prior to the hearings. See Affidavit of Doris Burnside, Exhibit A; see also Testimony of John McDonnell (for Applicant), Transcript, p. 70, printout attached hereto as Exhibit F (referring to one such meeting). In short, CALE's existence and leadership were well known to all parties before, during and after the hearings.

II. <u>CALE is entitled to petition the Board for review of the siting decision and to claim exemption from the fee for certification of the record.</u>

Applicant knew about CALE and was familiar with its leadership. Counsel for CALE indicated that she was representing other objectors. The hydrogeologist who testified in opposition to the expansion was identified as testifying for the citizens group. Applicant never objected to counsel's statement that she represented "other objectors" or questioned the reference to "our citizens group" during the hearings. Furthermore, Applicant does not claim that it was in any way prejudiced as a result of the manner of participation of CALE during the siting hearings. Applicant's claim that CALE did not participate in the hearings simply has no basis in fact. Thus, Applicant's attack on CALE's standing to appeal must fail.

Members of CALE petitioned for review as a citizens' group in order to claim the exemption allowed to such groups under Section 39.2(n) of the siting statute, which relates to payment of fees for certifying the record on appeal. 415 ILCS 5/39.2(n). Given the fact that the hearings lasted a week and involved extensive exhibits, Petitioner anticipated that such fees would be very high. Without the exemption, the cost of the appeal would have been prohibitive. The legislature clearly anticipated that an unincorporated, voluntary association would qualify for the exemption from the fees. The statute does not specify *how* a party that exists in the form of an unincorporated citizens' group must participate, only that it do so. CALE clearly did so in a manner consistent with its status as an informal association of concerned citizens. Thus, CALE has earned the right to petition for review by the Board and to claim exemption from the fee for certification of the record.

For the foregoing reasons, CALE respectfully requests that the PCB reject Applicant's attempt to avoid review, deny the Motion to Dismiss, grant Petitioner its reasonable fees and expenses incurred in opposing the Motion to Dismiss, and for such further relief as the Board may deem appropriate.

She said the new expansion would put the landfill site at 60 vertical feet.

"The proposed Kankakee County landfill would be 300 feet in height," she said.

"So many people affected by this landfill have not been heard from by our local government. There are 600 semis, six days a week, that use this facility These trucks get untarred and go this facility. These trucks get untarped and go under a video camera that checks their loads. This county does not check to see what goes into this landfill," said Gerwin.

"Our host county fee (agreement) could be retired but that is really a whole other issue. More landfill here means more risk," she said.

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Bush administration is casting Iraqi President Saddam Hussein as a menace who cannot be appeased and suggesting that it may not wait for full allied support before launching an attack.

"It's less important to have unanimity than it is making the right decision and doing the right thing, even though at the outset it may seem lonesome, Defense Secretary Donald H. Rumsfeld said Tuesday.

After President Bush met at his ranch in Crawford, Texas, nis ranch in Crawford, texas, with Saudi Arabia's Prince Ban-dar bin Sultan, White House spokesman Ari Fleischer said Bush told the Saudi ambassador he had not yet decided whether to attack.

"The president made very clear again that he believes that Saddam Hussein is a menace to world peace, a menace to regional peace," Fleischer said. The Saudis strongly oppose U.S.

The Saudis strongly oppose U.S. military action.

In a lively exchange with Marines at Camp Pendleton, Calif., Rumsfeld predicted that most U.S. friends and allies would support American U.S. military action against Iraq if that is what Bush decides is required to deal with the threat required to deal with the threat of being attacked with weapons of mass destruction. So far no allies have voiced firm support. Many have raised great doubts or outright opposition.

She said she had learned from EPA information submitted to the federal register that all landfill liners will eventually fail.

"It is kind of murky future. what happens 25 years after a landfill is closed. The city of Pontiac's water reservoir is close by and the Vermilion River is nearby," said Gerwin.

She said this landfill started as 18 acres, which was and is not lined, and with the expansion, will be 40 times as large.
