**Subject: Title 35: Subtitle C: Chapter I: Part 309-Permits (R03-19)**

Illinois-American Water Company (IL-AWC) provides water and wastewater service to over 290,000 customers in the Illinois operating districts of Alton, Belleville, Cairo, Champaign/Urbana, Chicago-Metro, East St. Louis, Granite City, Lincoln, Peoria, Peoria, Pontiac, Sterling and Streator. In total, Illinois-American provides service in 20 counties and 124 communities in Illinois.

On March 25, 2003, IL-AWC provided written comments on the petitioner's proposal to amend portions of Part 309. On April 2, 2003, IL-AWC attended a hearing on this matter and provided oral comments. We have followed the negotiations and amendments on this issue and IL-AWC supports the amendments as proposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board to Part 309 as published in the Illinois Register on September 19, 2003.
