OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie):

On August 19, 2025, the County of LaSalle (County) timely filed an administrative citation against Jody D. and Zara R. Harper. *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1(c) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 108.200(b)(3). The administrative citation concerns the Harpers’ property located at 2852 East U.S. Highway 52 in Sheridan, Mission Township, LaSalle County. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) as the “Harper Property” site and is designated with Site Code No. 0998215025. For the reasons below, the Board finds that the Harpers violated the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5 (2024)) and orders the Harpers to pay \$4,500 in civil penalties.

Under the Act, an administrative citation is an expedited enforcement action brought before the Board seeking civil penalties that are fixed by statute. Administrative citations may be filed only by the Agency or, if the Agency has delegated the authority, by a unit of local government, and only for limited types of alleged violations. *See* 415 ILCS 5/21(o), 21(p), 22.51, 22.51a, 31.1(c), 42(b)(4), 42(b)(4-5), 55(k) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.

In this case, the County alleges that on July 3, 2025, the Harpers violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), and 21(p)(7) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), 21(p)(7) (2024)) by causing or allowing open dumping in a manner that results in litter, open burning, and the deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris. The County asks the Board to impose the statutory \$1,500 civil penalty per violation on the Harpers, for a total civil penalty of \$4,500. As required, the County served the Harpers with the administrative citation on August 18, 2025, which is within “60 days after the date of the observed violation.” 415 ILCS 5/31.1(b) (2024); *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(c), 108.200(b)(1).

To contest an administrative citation, a respondent must file a petition with the Board no later than 35 days after being served with the administrative citation. If the respondent fails to do so, the Board must find that the respondent committed the violations alleged and impose the corresponding civil penalty. *See* 415 ILCS 31.1(d)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 108.204(b), 108.406. Here, any petition for review was due by Monday, September 22, 2025.

The Harpers failed to timely file a petition. Accordingly, the Board finds that Jody D. and Zara R. Harper violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), and 21(p)(7) of the Act.

The civil penalty for violating any provision of Section 21(p) is \$1,500 for each violation, except that the penalty amount is \$3,000 for each violation that is the person's second or subsequent adjudicated violation of that provision. *See* 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a). Because there are three violations of Section 21(p) and no indication in the record that any of these is a second or subsequent adjudicated violation, the total civil penalty is \$4,500. Under Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, the Board attaches the administrative citation and makes it part of the order below.

This opinion constitutes the Board's finding of fact and conclusions of law.

ORDER

1. The Board finds that Jody D. and Zara R. Harper violated Sections 21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), and 21(p)(7) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), 21(p)(3), 21(p)(7) (2024)).
2. Jody D. and Zara R. Harper must pay a civil penalty of \$4,500 no later than Monday, November 3, 2025, which is the first business day following the 30th day after the date of this order. Jody D. and Zara R. Harper must pay the civil penalty by two separate certified checks or money orders, each in the amount of \$2,250, the first made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and the second payable to the LaSalle County Department of Land Use. The case number and case name must appear on the certified checks or money orders.
3. Jody D. and Zara R. Harper must send the first certified check or money order for \$2,250 payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund to:

4. Penalties unpaid within the time prescribed will accrue interest under Section 42(g) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/42(g) (2024)) at the rate

set forth in Section 1003(a) of the Illinois Income Tax Act (35 ILCS 5/1003(a) (2024)).

5. Payment of this penalty does not prevent future prosecution if the violations continue.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

Section 41(a) of the Environmental Protection Act provides that final Board orders may be appealed directly to the Illinois Appellate Court within 35 days after the Board serves the order. 415 ILCS 5/41(a) (2024); *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(d)(2), 101.906, 102.706. Illinois Supreme Court Rule 335 establishes filing requirements that apply when the Illinois Appellate Court, by statute, directly reviews administrative orders. 172 Ill. 2d R. 335. The Board's procedural rules provide that motions for the Board to reconsider or modify its final orders may be filed with the Board within 35 days after the order is received. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.520; *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902, 102.700, 102.702. Filing a motion asking that the Board reconsider this final order is not a prerequisite to appealing the order. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902.

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1, formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, Ch. 111 ½, par. 1031.1, and delegated to the County of LaSalle pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 111 ½, par. 1004 (r).

FACTS

1. That Respondent, JODY D. & ZARA R. HARPER, is the present owner of the property located in Mission Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
2. That said facility is an open burn and open dump site, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and is designated with Site Code No. 0998215025. The said facility is commonly known to the Agency as the Harper Property.
3. That the Respondent has owned and operated said facility since at least 2001.
4. That on July 03, 2025, Lauren Grumieaux and Emma Gerkitz, of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. On the basis of direct observations of Lauren Grumieaux and Emma Gerkitz of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above-described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

That on July 03, 2025, an on-site inspection of said facility disclosed the following:

- XXX Causing or allowing litter -- 415 ILCS 5/21 (p) (1), (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1021 (p) (1) [formerly par. 1021 (q) (1)]).
- Causing or allowing scavenging operations -- 415 ILCS 5/21 (p) (2), (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 102 (p) (2) [formerly par. 1021 (q) (2)]).
- XXX Causing or allowing open burning -- 415 ILCS 5/21 (p) (3), (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1021(p) (3) [formerly par. 1021 (q) (3)]).
- Causing or allowing the deposition of waste in standing or flowing waters -- 415 ILCS 5/21 (p) (4), (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1021 (p) (4) [formerly par. 1021 (q) (4)]).
- Causing or allowing proliferation of disease vectors -- 415 ILCS 5/21 (p) (5), (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1021(p) (5) [formerly par. 1021 (q) (5)]).
- Causing or allowing the generation of standing or flowing liquid discharge from the open dump site -- 415 ILCS 5/21 (p) (6), (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1021(p) (6) [formerly par. 1021 (q) (6)]).
- XXX Causing or allowing the deposition of general construction or demolition debris, or clean construction or demolition debris in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

CIVIL PENALTY

6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4500.00). Additionally, should Respondents elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.

9. If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default, or finding after the adjudicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.







5. Within 90 days from the date of this Administrative Citation, remove all white goods (i.e., large appliances) to a facility that can legitimately accept them for recycling. White goods cannot be taken to a landfill or transfer station for the purpose of disposal.



NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

GENERAL REMARKS

On July 03, 2025, an open dumping inspection was conducted at 2885 E IL ST. RT. 52, Sheridan by Ms. Lauren Grumieaux and Ms. Emma Gerkitz, representing the LaSalle County Land Use Department, under the delegation authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The property is owned by Jody D. & Zara R. Harper, the children of the deceased Donald B. Harper Jr.

On March 26, 2025, an inspection was conducted in response to a complaint made on March 17, 2025, about possible dumping of engine fluids at Harper's Used Cars. The property had recently experienced a fatal fire. The family of the deceased is currently cleaning the property in preparation for sale. Dumpsters were on site, and about half of the cars, tires, and scrap have been removed. No signs of oil dumping were observed in the area. Barrels and tanks of oil and gas were on-site.

On June 30, 2025, Ms. Grumieaux and I visited again to check on the cleanup. Substantial progress had been made, with approximately one-quarter of the waste still remaining.

On July 03, 2025, the weather was sunny and 87°F. Winds were WSW at 3 mph.

Ms. Grumieaux and I arrived at the site at 03:05 p.m. and began the inspection.

Upon arrival, Ms. Grumieaux and I viewed a substantial burn pile actively burning, visible from the road. After pulling into the driveway, we made contact with Terry Harper. Ms. Grumieaux immediately requested that Ms. Harper cease all burning activities.

Facing east, I observed and documented large flames and thick black smoke emitting from the burn pile. (Photo #1) Throughout the conversation, Ms. Grumieaux suggested that the fire department be called to safely put the fire out. Upon closer inspection, we identified and documented burning materials, including tires, a roof structure, and other demolition debris remaining from the former shop. (Photo #2)

Continuing east, I documented additional scattered waste throughout the adjacent overgrown area, including more tires and demolition debris, connecting to the burn pile. (Photo #3 & #4) Facing southeast, the barrels previously recorded and previously observed to contain gas and oil, remained on site and were located near the active burn pile. (Photo #5)

Throughout the inspection, Ms. Grumieaux instructed that the burn pile be fully extinguished and all debris properly disposed of at a permitted landfill/facility. All disposal receipts are to be submitted as proof of proper waste and tire disposal. Ms. Harper stated she would contact the fire department to extinguish the fire. Looking north, I documented a separate pile of waste, tires, demolition debris, and other miscellaneous materials. (Photo #6) Ms. Grumieaux requested that the pile be removed and properly disposed of at a landfill. After documenting our findings, we concluded the inspection at 3:20 PM.


