OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On July 11, 2024, the County of DuPage (County) timely filed an administrative citation against The Beauty of the Land LLC (Beauty of the Land). *See* 415 ILCS 5/31.1(c) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 108.200(b)(3). The administrative citation concerns Beauty of the Land’s property located at 2040 W. Roosevelt Road in West Chicago, DuPage County. The property is commonly known to the County as the “the Beauty of the Land, LLC” site and is designated with Site Code No. 0430905896. For the reasons below, the Board finds that Beauty of the Land violated the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5 (2022)) and orders Beauty of the Land to pay \$1,500 in civil penalties.

Under the Act, an administrative citation is an expedited enforcement action brought before the Board seeking civil penalties that are fixed by statute. Administrative citations may be filed only by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) or, if the Agency has delegated the authority, by a unit of local government, and only for limited types of alleged violations. *See* 415 ILCS 5/21(o), 21(p), 22.51, 22.51a, 31.1(c), 42(b)(4), 42(b)(4-5), 55(k) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.

In this case, the County alleges that on June 11, 2024, Beauty of the Land violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2022)) by causing or allowing the open dumping of waste in a manner that results in litter. The County asks the Board to impose the statutory \$1,500 civil penalty per violation on Beauty of the Land, for a total civil penalty of \$1,500. As required, the County served Beauty of the Land with the administrative citation on July 18, 2024, which is within “60 days after the date of the observed violation.” 415 ILCS 5/31.1(b) (2022); *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(c), 108.200(b)(1).

To contest an administrative citation, a respondent must file a petition with the Board no later than 35 days after being served with the administrative citation. If the respondent fails to do so, the Board must find that the respondent committed the violations alleged and impose the corresponding civil penalty. *See* 415 ILCS 31.1(d)(1) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 108.204(b), 108.406. Here, any petition for review was due by August 22, 2024. Beauty of the Land failed to timely file a petition. Accordingly, the Board finds that Beauty of the Land violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Act.

The civil penalty for violating any provision of Section 21(p) is \$1,500 for each violation, except that the penalty amount is \$3,000 for each violation that is the person's second or subsequent adjudicated violation of that provision. *See* 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2022); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a). Because there is one violation of Section 21(p) and no indication in the record that any of these is a second or subsequent adjudicated violation, the total civil penalty is \$1,500. Under Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, the Board attaches the administrative citation and makes it part of the order below.

This opinion constitutes the Board's finding of fact and conclusions of law.

ORDER

1. The Board finds that Beauty of the Land violated Section 21(p)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2022)).
2. Beauty of the Land must pay a civil penalty of \$1,500 no later than Monday, October 7, 2024, which is the first business day following the 30th day after the date of this order. Beauty of the Land must pay the civil penalty by two separate certified checks or money orders, each in the amount of \$750, the first made payable to DuPage County, and the second made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund. The case number and case name must appear on each of the certified checks or money orders.

4. Penalties unpaid within the time prescribed will accrue interest under Section 42(g) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/42(g) (2022)) at the rate set forth in Section 1003(a) of the Illinois Income Tax Act (35 ILCS 5/1003(a) (2022)).

5. Payment of this penalty does not prevent future prosecution if the violations continue.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

Section 41(a) of the Environmental Protection Act provides that final Board orders may be appealed directly to the Illinois Appellate Court within 35 days after the Board serves the order. 415 ILCS 5/41(a) (2022); *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(d)(2), 101.906, 102.706. Illinois Supreme Court Rule 335 establishes filing requirements that apply when the Illinois Appellate Court, by statute, directly reviews administrative orders. 172 Ill. 2d R. 335. The Board's procedural rules provide that motions for the Board to reconsider or modify its final orders may be filed with the Board within 35 days after the order is received. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.520; *see also* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902, 102.700, 102.702. Filing a motion asking that the Board reconsider this final order is not a prerequisite to appealing the order. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902.



JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 *et. seq.* (1996), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1(b).

FACTS

1. Complainant, the COUNTY OF DUPAGE (hereafter the “COUNTY”), is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, (hereafter “the Act”), 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2007). The COUNTY is thus a “delegated unit” and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.

2. The Respondent, The Beauty of the Land, LLC, is the present occupant in control, ownership, and/or possession of the property situated at 2040 W Roosevelt Rd., West Chicago, located in the County of DuPage, State of Illinois.

3. The property is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code #0430905896. The facility is known to the COUNTY as “the Beauty of the Land, LLC site.”

4. The Respondent has occupied, controlled and/or operated the Beauty of the Land, LLC site at all relevant times hereto.

5. On June 11, 2024, Austin Knight, Environmental Specialist for DUPAGE COUNTY as delegated by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the Beauty of the Land, LLC site. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Mr. Knight’s Affidavit, is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully stated herein.

6. Based upon direct observations made by Mr. Knight during his inspection, the COUNTY has determined that, on or about June 11, 2024, Respondent violated the Act, including but not limited to as follows:

- a. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2007).

REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, Complainant, the COUNTY OF DUPAGE, respectfully requests that the POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD: (i) find that, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00); (ii) order Respondent to pay \$1,500.00 to the COUNTY; (iii) order Respondent to immediately remove all waste and/or litter from the site premises; and (iv) order Respondent to cease and desist any further dumping of waste on the Beauty of the Land, LLC site.

Notices and Instructions to Respondent

1. **You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation.** The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
2. To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send two (2) checks or money orders with the attached Remittance Form, one check in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars payable to DuPage County and the second check or money order in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to:

To ensure that you receive timely and proper credit for your payment, complete the attached Remittance Form and include it with your payment.

3. You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (“Board”).
4. **Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.**

7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. *See* Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).
8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by the County of DuPage and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.
10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the DuPage County Office of the State's Attorney may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event, you may also be liable for court costs.

AFFIDAVIT BY THE PERSONNEL RECORDING THE VIOLATION

I, AUSTIN KNIGHT, under penalty of perjury and pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1(b)(5), do hereby depose and state that the following facts are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. I am over twenty-one (21) years of age and under no legal disability.
2. I am currently employed as an Inspector for the County of DuPage, Illinois, Department of Building and Zoning, a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated its enforcement powers, pursuant to the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/4(r).
3. As an Inspector for the County of DuPage, Department of Building and Zoning, my responsibilities include, but are not limited to, conducting inspections of property located within the County of DuPage, Illinois, for violations of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act.
4. On or about June 4, 2024, the DuPage County Department of Building and Zoning received a complaint that the property situated at 2040 W Roosevelt Rd., West Chicago, IL, and owned by The Beauty of the Land, LLC, had been receiving and/or storing landscape waste without a permit.
5. On or about June 11, 2024, I conducted an on-site inspection of the property located at 2040 W Roosevelt Rd. West Chicago, IL (hereafter "the site").
6. I arrived at the site on June 11, 2024, and parked in the lot. I immediately proceeded to the building entrance for The Beauty of the Land, LLC., where I knocked on the door and checked the fenced area just east of the building, but I did not see anyone on site at that time.
7. I then headed west before proceeding south towards the rear of the property, where I noted a cleared area with piles of landscape material that appeared to have been generated


off-site. I also observed an open gate leading to the area where the landscape waste was located. I further noted tire marks on the ground surface leading from the opened gate to the area of the landscape waste piles.


8. I took photographs showing the presence of the piles of landscape waste, the open gate, and the tire tracks. I also completed an Inspection Report. The photographs and Inspection Report, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," truly and accurately depict and describe the property situated at 2040 W. Roosevelt Rd., West Chicago, IL, as it existed on June 11, 2024. An aerial photograph of the site has also been included in Exhibit A, with said photograph being obtained from <https://gis.dupageco.org/parcelviewer/> on December 11, 2023 (during the course of a previous inspection), and marked by me to show the location(s) where each photograph was taken on July 11, 2024.
9. On June 11, 2024, during my inspection, I observed the following violation(s) present on the property situated at 2040 W. Roosevelt Rd., West Chicago, IL, and owned by Beauty of the Land, LLC, including but not limited to:
 - a. Pursuant to Section 21(p)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)), no person shall: Cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in litter at the dump site: Litter.



General Remarks

Pre-inspection note: On December 11, 2023, I conducted an inspection of the site in response to burning of off-site generated landscape waste. I observed a pile of ash containing landscape waste emitting smoke. Violation Notice L-2023-DP1140 was issued to Miguel Barrios as a result of the inspection. On January 17, 2024, Mr. Barrios entered into a compliance commitment agreement with DuPage County agreeing to immediately cease and desist disposing of and storing landscape waste at the site. The CCA addressed the removal of landscape waste and proper disposal in the future in addition to permit application if the site wanted to continue to operate as a landscape waste disposal, storage, or transfer site. The CCA was executed by Mr. Barrios on January 17, 2024. A re-inspection was completed on January 29th, during which the violations alleged in VN L-2023-DP1140 had been remedied.

This June 11, 2024, inspection was conducted in response to a complaint that alleged the site had been receiving and storing landscape waste.

I arrived at the site and parked in the lot. I then proceeded to the building entrance where I knocked on the door and checked the fenced area just east of the building, but I did not see anyone on site at that time. I then headed west before turning south towards the rear of the property where I noted a cleared area with piles of landscape material that appeared to have been generated off-site. I also observed an open gate leading to the area where the landscape waste was located. I noted tire marks on the ground surface.

I then exited the site. At that time, the site was found to be in violation as described in Attachment A and depicted in the following photographs. {End}

ATTACHMENT A

- Pursuant to Section 21(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(a)), no person shall: Cause or allow open dumping.

The Site is in violation of Section 21(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(a), for the following reason: at the time of this inspection, evidence of open dumping of landscape waste was observed on the site.

- Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)), no person shall: conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste disposal operation without a permit.

The Site is in violation of Section 21(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1) for the following reason: At the time of inspection, the site appeared to have been conducting a waste-storage, waste-disposal and waste-treatment operation without a permit.

- Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(e)), Dispose, treat, store, or abandon waste, or transport waste into Illinois for such activities, except at a site meeting Act and regulatory requirements.

The Site is in violation of Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(e)) for the following reason: At the time of inspection, waste was observed abandoned at a site which does not meet the conditions set forth in the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act.

- Pursuant to Section 21(p)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)), no person shall: Cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in litter at the dump site: Litter.

The Site is in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) for the following reason: At the time of inspection, the site appeared to have been allowing or causing the open dumping of landscape waste causing litter.

- Pursuant to Section 807.201 Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 IAC) no person shall cause or allow the development of any new solid waste management site or cause or allow the modification of an existing solid waste management site without a Development Permit issued by the Agency.

The Site is in violation of Section 807.201 Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 IAC) for the following reason: At the time of inspection, off-site generated landscape waste was observed at the site being accepted and stored without a permit.

- Pursuant to Section 807.202 Operating Permits Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 IAC) no person shall cause or allow the use or operation of any solid waste management site for which a Development Permit is required under Section 807.201 without an Operating Permit issued by the Agency, except for such testing operations as may be authorized by the Development Permit.

The Site is in violation of Section 807.202 Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 IAC) for the following reason: At the time of inspection, off-site generated landscape waste at the site being accepted and stored without a permit.
