**RESPONDENT’S MOTION TO EXTEND  
SUMMARY JUDGMENT RESPONSE DATE**

Now comes Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, by KWAME RAOUL, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and respectfully request that the Hearing Officer extend the date for filing responses to the cross-motions for summary judgment until April 30, 2026. In support, Respondent states as follows:

1. On March 2, 2026, at the Parties’ request, the Hearing Officer granted Petitioner’s Motion to Amend Summary Judgment Briefing Schedule and set the date for filing Motions for Summary Judgment for March 3, 2026, with Responses Due April 3, 2026.
2. The Parties have now filed their Motions for Summary Judgment, but Respondent seeks to extend the date for filing Responses until April 30, 2026.
3. The basis for Respondent’s request is that, in accordance with office policy, the Response will need review and approval of management. However, because of a previously scheduled vacation, Bureau Chief Stephen Sylvester will be out of the country from approximately the current date of filing until at least April 16, 2026. Accordingly, the undersigned will not be able to obtain review and approval until his return.

4. The undersigned has consulted with counsel for Petitioner, who advises that he has no objection to extending the date for Responses until April 30, 2026.

5. Petitioner has provided an open waiver of the Board's decision deadline, and granting this request should not create an unreasonable delay in resolution of this Matter.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer extend the date for filing the Parties' Responses to Motions for Summary Judgment until April 30, 2026.
