
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On April 7, 2026, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Chem-Plate Industries, LLC (Chem-Plate) may appeal a March 3, 2026 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency denied Chem-Plate’s modification to the approved closure plant for its hazardous waste storage area at its facility in Maywood, Cook County.

The parties’ request seeks an extension of not more than 125 days from Chem-Plate’s receipt of the Agency’s determination or until “July 13, 2026.” Request at 1. The Board extends the appeal period until Monday, July 13, 2026, which, as the parties request, is the first business day after the 125th day after Chem-Plate’s March 10, 2026 receipt of the Agency’s determination. *See id.*; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Chem-Plate fails to file an appeal on or before July 13, 2026, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
