## **HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

The Board opened this rulemaking to propose updated regulations governing noise found in 35 Ill. Adm. Code Subtitle H, pursuant to Sections 27 and 28 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, (415 ILCS 5/27-5/28 (2002) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 102 Subpart B. On March 17, 2005, the Board adopted a first-notice proposal in this proceeding and the proposal was published in the *Illinois Register* on April 15, 2005.

On May 27, 2005, the Illinois Association of Aggregate Producers filed a public comment and a request for hearing pursuant to Section 5-40 of the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act (5 ILCS 100/5-40 (2002). The Board must therefore schedule a sixth hearing in this matter. The purpose of this additional hearing is to allow all interested persons the opportunity to present testimony on the proposed rules.

Persons who wish to testify at the September 1, 2005 hearing must prefile their testimony by August 11, 2005. Prefiled testimony must be filed with the Board and served on all persons
