Thank you for providing the community with the opportunity to participate in the upcoming public hearing.

After speaking with a number of concerned residents from the Lemont and surrounding communities, we respectfully ask if the Board would consider moving the hearing to a later afternoon or evening time, if possible.

Many residents who are directly impacted by this issue are working individuals, parents, caregivers, and community members who are unable to take time off work during the middle of the day. An 11:00 a.m. hearing unfortunately creates a significant barrier for public participation and limits the ability of residents to attend, listen, and provide meaningful input on an issue that deeply affects our community.
