
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M.D. Mankowski):

On April 7, 2026, the Appellate Court First District issued a mandate in Chronister Oil Company v. Pollution Control Board, et al., 2026 IL App (4th) 250398-U. The Court reviewed the Board's March 20, 2025, order granting summary judgment in favor of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and denying Chronister Oil Company's motion for summary judgment.

The Appellate Court reversed and remanded the Board's decision. The Board directs the parties and the Board's hearing officer to proceed with this case in accordance with the Appellate Court's decision.
