**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Now Comes Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (“Illinois EPA”), through its counsel, the Illinois Attorney General’s Office, and hereby requests that the Board allow additional time, until June 25, 2026, for the filing of Respondent’s Response to Petitioner’s Motion to Supplement Record on Appeal (“Response”) in this matter. In support of its request, Respondent states as follows:

1. On October 30, 2025, Petitioner filed its Petition for Review of Illinois EPA Decision (“Petition”) with the Board.
2. On January 14, 2026, Respondent filed the record of determination as ordered by the Board on January 5, 2026.
3. On June 4, 2026, Petitioner filed its Motion to Supplement Record on Appeal.
4. Section 101.500(d) of the Board’s General Rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d), provides as follows:
  - d) Within 14 days after service of a motion, a party may file a response to the motion. . . . Parties may request that the Board grant more time to respond by filing a motion for extension of time before the response period expires.
5. Section 101.522 of the Board’s General Rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.522, provides

as follows:

If a party's motion shows good cause, the Board or hearing officer may extend any deadline required by this Part. The motion may be filed either before or after the deadline requires.

6. Due to other professional obligations and summer vacations, Respondent will be unable to file its Response by June 18, 2025. Respondent believes that it will be able to file its Response within 7 additional days, or by June 25, 2026.

7. Section 101.500(d) allows Respondent to seek additional time to file a response to a motion before the response period expires. In this instance, Respondent is seeking additional time before the June 18, 2026, due date. Respondent believes that it will be able to file its Response within 7 additional days, by June 25, 2026.

8. Under Section 101.522 of the Board's General Rules, the Board or hearing officer may extend any deadline required under the Board's General Rules, which are "generally applicable to proceedings before the Illinois Pollution Control Board" (*see* Section 101.100(a)) if a party's motion shows good cause. In this instance, the requested extension would allow Respondent additional time to file a complete and adequate response.

9. The undersigned has contacted counsel for Petitioner, who advised that he does not object to Respondent's request.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, the ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, respectfully requests that the Board grant its Motion and extend the deadline for filing its Response to Petitioner's Motion to Supplement Record on Appeal to June 25, 2026.
