The reason for this email is to oppose Citgo's request to release MORE carbon monoxide into the air as part of case# AS 2026-001.

I live in Lockport with my family, a half mile from the refinery. I grew up in this same neighborhood, as did my mom. My family and I moved back because there is so much to love about this area. The refinery has always been a compromise and we are grateful for the green spaces they leave undeveloped.

However, by allowing this extra release of a TOXIC gas, this would be putting my 4 and 2 year olds at greater risk of issues later in life. The decisions made today affect their futures.

Citgo was also cited with over 2 dozen Clean Air Act violations back in January of 2026. Which included 2 carbon monoxide emission exceedences. So... if they're told "no" will they even listen?
