It appears the Board may have filed an incorrect notice page for the proposed amendments to 2 Ill. Adm. Code 2175. Item 5 in the Notice of Proposed Amendment (“NT-P” attached) explains amendments to Section 101.302; however Section 101.302 is not included in the rulemaking (“RG-P” also attached). If this is an error, would the Board like to file a replacement notice page or register pages with the Secretary of State to correct this text before publication? If so, can that be completed today?
