
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. Gibson):

On July 2, 2026, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Mac's Convenience Stores, LLC (Mac's Convenience Stores) may appeal a June 8, 2026 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency partially denied payment from the Underground Storage Tank fund for the underground storage tank located at 1827 18th Avenue in East Moline, Rock Island County.

The parties' request seeks an extension of not more than 125 days from Mac's Convenience Stores' receipt of the Agency's determination or until "October 15, 2026." Request at 1. The Board extends the appeal period until Thursday, October 15, 2026, which, as the parties request, is the first business day after the 125th day after Mac's Convenience Stores' June 12, 2026 receipt of the Agency's determination. *See id.*; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Mac's Convenience Stores fails to file an appeal on or before October 15, 2026, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
