ORDER OF THE BOARD (by A. Tin):

On June 16, 2026, Phillips 66 Company (Phillips) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss, without prejudice, its petition for variance. The petition, which was filed on May 7, 2026, concerns a request for relief from Board regulations governing nitrogen oxides emissions for two process heaters at Phillips' Wood River Refinery located at 900 South Central Avenue in Roxana, Madison County. Phillips had sought a variance from compliance dates in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 217.152(e) and Appendix I of Part 217 applicable to an HTR-SMR Steam Methane Reformer and a Rectified Absorber Unit Heater. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency filed no response to Phillips' motion and therefore waives any objection to the Board granting it. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500(d). The Board grants Phillips' motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the petition without prejudice, and closes the docket.
