APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the Board's June 4, 2026 regular open meeting were approved by a roll call vote of 4-0.

RULEMAKINGS

<u>R22-18(A)</u>	Proposed Amendments to Groundwater Quality (35 Ill. Adm. Code 620) (Public Water Supply) – The Board adopted a first-notice proposal to amend the Board's groundwater rules. The Board proposes to strike the exemptions for Part 811 and 814 landfills at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 620.410(f) and 620.420(e) and declines to add an exemption for Part 807 landfills.	4-0 roll call vote
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<u>R26-18</u>	<u>Rulemaking for Filing Fee Increase 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.302, 2 Ill. Adm. Code 2175.200 (Procedural, Administrative)</u> – The Board adopted first-notice proposal to amend Section 101.302 and repeal Section 2175.200, reflecting changes made to 415 ILCS 5/7.5 in Public Act 104-0466, which raised the Board’s filing fees from \$75 to \$250.	4-0 roll call vote

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ADMINISTRATIVE CITATIONS

<u>AC 26-6</u>	<u>County of LaSalle v. Judith Schuster Trustee (Land)</u> – After Judith Schuster failed to timely file a petition to contest this administrative citation, the Board found that she violated Section 21(p)(1) and (p)(2) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), (p)(2) (2024)) as alleged. Because there were two violations, the Board ordered Judith Schuster to pay a total civil penalty of \$3,000, reflecting the statutory penalty of \$1,500 per violation.	4-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 24-78</u>	<u>PIA AvCenter LLC d/b/a Byerly Aviation v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (UST Appeal)</u> – the Board denied both Byerly Aviation’s and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency motions for summary judgment and directs the hearing officer to proceed to hearing.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 25-40</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Royal Creation Inc. and Stefon Givens (Land, Water – Enforcement)</u> – Held.	No action taken.
<u>PCB 26-53</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Randy Peter and Debra Peter (Air, Land, Water – Enforcement)</u> – Upon receiving a stipulation, proposed settlement, and motion for relief from the hearing requirement in this enforcement action concerning Randy Peter and Debra Peter’s parcels in Adams County, the Board directed the Clerk to provide the required newspaper notice.	4-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 26-57</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. County Line Swine, Inc.</u> (Water, NPDES – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning County Line Swine’s Adams County swine and cattle farm, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1)(2024)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered County Line Swine to pay a \$5,000 civil penalty, and to cease and desist from future violations.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-60</u>	<u>Greater Rockford Airport Authority v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board granted the parties’ request to extend the appeal period to September 28, 2026.	4-0 roll call vote

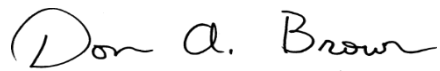
OTHER ITEMS
