Code 219, Organic Material Emissions Standards for the Metro East Area (Air)</u> – The Board adopted a final opinion and order in this rulemaking to amend Part 219's aerospace coating requirements for volatile organic material (VOM) emissions in the Metro East area by adding a limited exemption for low volumes of primers, topcoats, and chemical milling maskants at aerospace facilities.	4-0 roll call vote

ADJUDICATORY CASES

<u>PCB 25-40</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Royal Creation Inc. and Stefon Givens</u> (Water – Enforcement) – The Board granted the People’s unopposed motion to deem facts admitted. The Board also granted the People’s unopposed motion for summary judgment against Respondents on Counts I, II, III, V, VI, and VII and therefore found that they violated Sections 12(a), 12(d), 21(a), 21(e), 21(p)(1), and 21(p)(6) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/12(a), 12(d), 21(a), 21(e), 21(p)(1), 21(p)(6) (2024)). However, the Board denied the People’s unopposed motion for summary judgment against Respondents on Count IV because there is a genuine issue of material fact regarding the alleged violation of Section 21(d)(1) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1) (2024)). The Board directed the parties to proceed to hearing on Count IV and, as it may apply to the People’s requested remediation, proportionate share liability.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-28</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. M&A Precision Truck and Auto Repair, Inc.</u> (Water; Land, UIC – Enforcement) – Upon receiving a stipulation, proposed settlement, and motion for relief from the hearing requirement in this enforcement action concerning M&A’s diesel truck maintenance and repair facility in McHenry County, the Board directed the Clerk to provide the required newspaper notice.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-50</u>	<u>Premcor Refining Group, Inc. v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Land, RCRA – Permit Appeal) – The Board accepted for hearing this appeal of IEPA’s determination on Premcor Refining Group’s Corrective Measures Completion Report for the Soil Vapor Extraction System plan concerning its Madison County terminal.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-58</u>	<u>Phillips 66 Company v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Air – Variance) – The Board granted Phillips 66 Company’s motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal without prejudice and closed the docket.	4-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 26-59</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Keshav Investments, LLC d/b/a CD One Price Cleaners #9</u> (Air – Enforcement) – Upon receiving a stipulation, proposed settlement, and motion for relief from the hearing requirement in this enforcement action concerning Keshav Investments’ dry-cleaning facility in Cook County, the Board directed the Clerk to provide the required newspaper notice.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 26-62</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Meyer Industrial Container LLC</u> (Air, CAAPP – Enforcement) – The Board accepted for hearing the People’s complaint concerning Meyer Industrial Container’s recycling facility in Cook County.	4-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 27-1</u>	<u>Mac’s Convenience Stores, LLC v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (UST Appeal) – The Board granted the parties’ joint request to extend the appeal period to October 15, 2026.	4-0 roll call vote

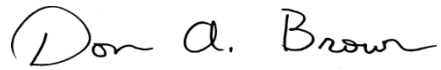
