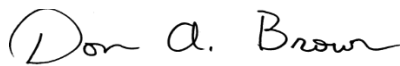
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by A. Liva):

On July 24, 2026, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which United States Steel Corporation (U.S. Steel) may appeal a June 24, 2026, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). On July 29, 2026, U.S. Steel filed an amended joint request for extension of time. The amended request added e-mail correspondence from the Agency indicating it consented to a 45-day extension of the appeal period. In the determination, the Agency issued a final National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for U.S. Steel's Granite City Works facility located at 20th and State Street, Granite City, Madison County.

The Board extends the appeal period until September 14, 2026, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2024); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If U.S. Steel fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
