Proposed Rule. Dismissal Order.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. D. Mankowski):

Section 13(c) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/13(c) (2024)) requires the Board to adopt regulations that are “identical in substance” to regulations adopted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA). 415 ILCS 5/7.2 (2024). Specifically, Section 13(c) relates to underground injection control (UIC) regulations that USEPA adopted to implement provisions of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. §§ 300h et seq. (2024)). USEPA codified its UIC regulations at 40 C.F.R. 144 through 148.

The Board reserved this docket for USEPA amendments to UIC regulations adopted between January 1, 2026 and June 30, 2026. During that time, USEPA did not amend UIC regulations.

No Board rulemaking action is necessary, and the Board dismisses this docket.
